CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT (In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources thereunder.)

This is to certify that C. A. CUMMINS of Home Valley, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring, with point or points of diversion within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 27, Twp. 3 N., R. 8 E., W.M., under and subject to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. 6286 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of record in Volume 9, at Page 4133, on the 31st day of July, 1951. that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is July 27, 1949; that the amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.025 of a cubic foot per second for fish propagation and irrigation of 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acres.
