This is to certify that PORTLAND LOCAL COUNCIL GIRLS COUTS, INCORPORATED of Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Collins Creek, a tributary of Columbia River, with point or points of diversion within the SEZ of NEZ of Sec. 25, Twp. 3 No., R. 8 E., W. M., under and subject to provisions contained in Appropriation Permit No. 6280 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of record in Volume 9, at Page 4389, on the 29th day of November, 1951 that the priority date of the right nereby confirmed is October 2, 1968; that the amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.25 of a cubic foot per second for the purpose of domestic supply for

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

All of Sec. 24, EXCEPT the N_2^1 of SE_4^1 of NW_4^1 and S_2^1 of SE_4^1 of NE_4^2 and NE_4^2 of NE_4^1 of SE_4^1 of Sec. 24, Twp. 3 N., Rge. 8 E.W.M.;

NE¹, the SE¹/₄ and all of the SW¹/₄ of Sec. 25, Twp. 3 N., Rge. 8 E.W.M., SAVE AND EXCEPT from SW¹/₄, "9 1/16 acres in the Northwest corner of said quarter section; particularly described as follows: being 50 rods South; thence 29 rods East; thence 50 rods Nort; thence 29 rods West to said corner post, also except 14½ acres more or less, on this South side of the SE½ of SW¹/₄ of Sec. 25, Twp. 3 N., Rge. 8 E. W. M., same being continued to the South side of Rock Creek and Collins County Road, and meandering line thereof as now established and of record, particularly described as follows, to wit;

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the SW\(\frac{1}{2}\) of Sec. 25 Twp. 3 N., Rge. 8 E.W.M., running thence West on the line, 80 rods; thence North 20 rods, to a stake on the South side of said Rock Creek and Collins County Road; thence 690 feet in a Northeasterly direction on South line of said road, and conforming meander line thereof, to a stake; thence 450 ft. in a SouthWasterly direction, on South side of said County Road; and conforming to meander line thereof to a stake, which stake is 330 ft. North; and 180 ft. The right to the use of the water afcresaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
