P. U. D. #1, SKAMANIA COUNTY of Stevenson, Washington is hereby granted a permit to appropriate the following described public water of the State of Washington, subject to existing rights and to the following limitations and provisions: Permittee shall construct and maintain at his own expense a welr, or other suitable device, for measuring any water granted herein for irrigation purposed and such appropriation shall be subject to a reasonable rotation system if ordered by the State Supervisor of Water Resources. It is further provided that the diversion intake shall be tightly presented at all times with wire having a mesh opening not greater than 125 (1/8) inch.

Priority date of this permit is December 12, 1951

Source of the proposed appropriation is Bear Creek tabutary of Wind River.

The quantity of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be beneficially applied and not to exceed 5.0 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, to be used for the following purposes: Community Domestic Supply as more definitely set out below.
