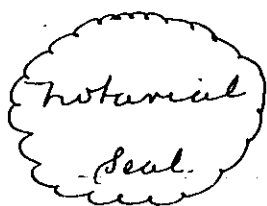

Mitchell his heirs and assigns forever; and the title to the foregoing described premises, and every part thereof I bind myself and my heirs and legal representatives to forever warrant and defend unto the said P. E. Mitchell and to his heirs, assigns and legal representatives against the lawful claims of all persons claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
