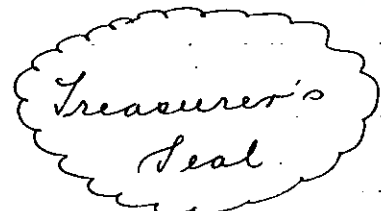
This Indenture made this 28th day of December A.D. 1901, between Frank Marble, as Treasurer of Skamania County, State of Washington, party of the first part, and Henry Carter of Pierce County, Washington, party of the second part:

Witnesseth, that, whereas, at a public sale of real estate held on the 28th day of December A.D. 1901, pursuant to a real estate tax judgment entered in the Superior Court of the County of Skamania on the Fourteenth day of December A.D. 1901 in proceedings to foreclose tax liens upon real estate and an order of sale duly issued by said court, Henry Carter, party of the second part, duly purchased in compliance with the laws of the State of Washington, the following described real estate, to wit:

The N. E. 1/4 of Sec. 17 in Twp. 2 North of Range 5 East of R. M. and that said Henry Carter has complied with the laws of the State of Washington necessary to entitle him to a deed for said real estate.

Now, Therefore, knowye, that I, Frank Marble County Treasurer of said Skamania County, State of Washington, in consideration of the premises and by virtue of the statutes of the State of Washington, in such cases provided, do hereby grant and convey unto Henry Carter, his heirs and assigns, forever the said real estate hereinbefore described.
