This is to certify that CLARENCE E. & ALISON O. BOYLE of North Bonneville, State of W. shington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Columbia River with point or points of diversion within the NWL of NEL of Sec. 11, Twp. 1 N.R. 5 E., W.M., under and subject to provisions contained in Appropriation Permint No. 7074 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed 1, y the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of record in Volume 11, at Page 5227, on the 2nd day of June, 1953 that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is December 2, 1950; that the amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not accord

0.01 of a cubic foot per second for the purpose of domestic supply.

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A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Commencing at the Southwesterly corner of Lot 1, Block "3" of the Townsite of Prindle according the official plat thereof on file and of fecord in the office of the County Auditor of Skamania County, Washington; thence North 10 44' West along the Westerly line of Block "B" of said Townsite of Prindle a distance of 200 feet; thence at right angle Westerly a distance of 450 feet; thence at right angle Southerly to the North line of the Spokane, Portland, & Seattle Mailway Company right-of-way; thence North 68°24' East along the Northerly line of said right-of-way to a point which is South 22°26' East to the place of beginning; thence North 22°26' West to the point of beginning.
