CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

This is to certify that R. S. & R. R. SAMPSON of Washougal, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Columbia River, with point or points of diversion within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 10, Twp. 1 N., R. 5 E., W.M., under and subject to provisions contained in Appropriation Permit No. 4903 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of record in Volume 11, at Page 5488, on the 5th day of November, 1953 that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is September 14, 1916, that the amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.3 of a cubic foot per second for the purpose of the irrigation of 23 acres.
