CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, that JAMES J. ARCHER of Carson, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring, with point or points of diversion within the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 14, Twp. 4 N., Range 7 E. W. M., for the purposes of domestic supply under Appropriation Permit No. 4669 issued by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the Laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume 7, at Page 3138, on the 17th day of September, 1948; that the right hereby confirmed dates from February 18, 1946; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 of a cubic foot per second

A description of the lands under such right to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Charles H. Hutto to Ida L. Hutto

COMMUNITY PROPERTY AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Charles H. Hutto, husband, of Ida L. Hutto, of Ridgefield, Washington, and I, Ida L. Hutto, wife, of the same place, for and in consideration of the love and affection we each bear, one toward the other, and further in consideration of the mutual helpfulness we have been, one to the other, in the past, and for and in consideration of the commingling of our joint efforts in earnings heretofore, do

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mutually agree at this time, the one with the other, as follows:

FIRST: That each and every piece, parcel, lot or tract of land, wherever situated, either in Clark County, Washington, or in any other County in the State of Washington, and each and every part of the personal property, wheresoever situate, and each and every particle of mixed property, wheresoever situate, shall be by us and all other persons whomsoever, deemed, esteemed, regarded, treated and know as community property. In this agreement so made one with the other, the date of acquiring, the manner of acquiring and all statements by either of us made respecting alleged separate property, or affecting any property, is to be regarded and esteemed as of no effect, the full intent and purpose of this instrument is to be construed by the Court, our heirs, executors and assigns and by all other persons whomsoever, as a voluntary conveyance from one to the other and unitedly to the community of all our earthly possessions in such form and manner that the same shall from this date be the property of the community of ourselves as husband and wife.

SECOND: And being desirous that said property shall pass unto the survivor without delay or expense in case of the death of either of the said husband or of the said wife, that in case of the death of the said Charles H. Hutto, while the said Ida L. Hutto survives, the said community property as above stated, now owned by us or which may hereafter be acquired by us, shall at once vest in the said Ida L. Hutto, in fee simple as her sole and separate property; and in the event of the death of the said Ida L. Hutto leaving the said Charles H. Hutto surviving her, the whole of said property now owned by us or which may hereafter be acquired by us shall at once vest in the said Charles H. Hutto in fee simple and as his sole and separate property.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto, being the said Charles H. Hutto and the Ida L. Hutto, have hereunto set their hands and seal in duplicate this 22nd day of July 1943.
