

B. F. Fuller to Ada G. Baker

This Indenture, Made this 27th day of November A.D. 1903 by and between B. F. Fuller and Emma Fuller, husband and wife, Mortgagors, and Ada G. Baker of Colorado Springs, Colorado, Mortgagee, Witnesseth, That said Mortgagors for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred fifty $\$250$ Dollars, to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, aliened released, conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do bargain, sell, alien, release, convey and confirm unto the said mortgagee, her heirs and assigns forever, all the following described real estate, situate in the County of Clallam and State of Washington, to-wit: The Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter and the North half of the South half of the Northeast quarter of Section one (1) Township Three (3) North, Range Nine (9) East Willamette Meridian, containing, eighty (80) acres, according to U.S. Plat and Surveys. Together with the covenants, agreements and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining for to have and to hold unto the said mortgagee her heirs and assigns forever.

This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Two hundred fifty $\$250$ Dollars, in accordance with the tenor of a certain promissory note, of which the following is a copy to-wit:

Three years after Date, without grace & we or either of us promise to pay to the order of Ada G. Baker at the Office of John Leland Henderson in Hood River, Oregon, Two hundred fifty Dollars in Gold Coin of the United States of America, of the present standard value, with interest thereon in like Gold Coin at the rate of ten per cent. per annum from Date until paid, or value received; Interest to be paid annually. And if not so paid, the whole sum of both principal and interest to become immediately due and collectable, at the option of the holder of this note. And in case suit or action is instituted to collect this note or any portion thereof, we or either of us promise to agree to pay, in addition to the costs and disbursements provided by statute, such additional sum in like Gold Coin, as the Court may adjudge reasonable for attorney's fees to be allowed in said suit or action.
