ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

WE, N. C. CHRISTENSON, OF PORTLAND, OREGON, E. L. BORN, OF UNDERWOOD, SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON, S. H. SILKWORTH, OF PORTLAND, OREGON, AND L. N. BISHOP, OF UNDERWOOD, SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON, WHOSE NAMES ARE SUBSCRIBED HEREUNTO DO HERESY ASSOCIATE OURSELVES TOGETHER FOR THE PURPOSE OF FORMING A CORPORATION UNDER AND BY VIRTUE OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON IN FORCE AND EFFECT FOR THE FORMATION OF PRIVATE CORPORATIONS AND THE APPROPRIATION OF PRIVATE PROPERTY THEREFOR;

1. THE NAME OF THIS CORPORATION SHALL BE CRESCENT LUMBER COMPANY AND ITS DURATION SHALL BE FIFTY YEARS;

2. THE OBJECT OF THE CORPORATION AND THE BUSINESS IN WHICH IT PURSU-SES TO ENGAGE IS AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT: TO OPERATE A GENERAL LOGGING AND LUMBER BUSINESS AND TO PURCHASE OR OTHERWISE ACQUIRE AND TO HOLD, LEASE AND SELL TIMBER, MINERAL AND OTHER LANDS AND THE PRODUCTS THEREOF; TO BUILD, CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE SHOPS, SAWMILLS AND FACTORIES FOR THE HANDLING OF LOGS, TIMBER AND LUMBER AND FOR PLANING, DRESSING AND PREPARING VARIOUS PRODUCTS OF SUCH LANDS FOR MARKET; TO BUY, SELL, IMPORT, EXPORT AND GENERALLY DEAL AND TRADE IN WOOD, LUMBER LOGS, AND TIMBER; TO CONDUCT AND TRANSACT ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO CARRY INTO FULL FORCE AND EFFECT THE OPERATION OF LOGGING AND LUMBER BUSINESS AND TO TRANSACT BUSINESS IN ANY STATE OR TERRITORY OR IN ANY FOREIGN COUNTRY AND TO MAINTAIN OFFICE AND CONDUCT BUSINESS THEREIN,

3. THE PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND PLACE OF BUSINESS OF THIS CORPORATION SHALL BE AT UNDERWOOD, IN THE COUNTY OF SKAMANIA, STATE OF WASHINGTON, AND THAT TWO OF THE PERSONS SUBSCRIBING TO THE ARTICLES ARE RESIDENTS OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, TO-WIT: E. L. BORN OF UNDERWOOD, WASHINGTON AND L. N. BISHOP, OF UNDERWOOD, WASHINGTON;

4. THE CAPITAL STOCK OF THIS CORPORATION SHALL BE \$25,000.00;

5. THE CAPITAL STOCK SHALL BE DIVIDED INTO TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY (250) SHARES AND THE PAR VALUE OF EACH SHARE SHALL BE THE SUM OF \$100.00;

6. THE CORPORATE POWERS OF THE COMPANY SHALL BE EXERCISED BY A BOARD OF TRUSTEES AS PROVIDED BY LAW AS FOLLOWS: N. C. CHRISTENSON, E. L. BORN, S. H. SILKWORTH AND L. N. BISHOP; TO MANAGE THE CONCERNS OF THE CO. UNTIL MAY 15TH, 1921.
