The south-west quarter (S.W.<sup>4</sup>) of Section Thirty (30) in Township Three (3) North of Range Nine (9) East of the Willamette Meridian, containing one hundred and sixty acres. Together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining; and also the estate, right, title and interest of the said parties of the first part, of, in and to the same. To have and to hold the hereinbefore granted, bargained and described premises, with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever. Gold Coin of present standard value, at the office of Mc Neese & Wilson, The Dalles, Oregon, interest payable annually; and if not so paid, then both principal and interest to become immediately due and collectible at the option of the holder of this note; and in case suit or action is instituted to collect this note or any portion thereof, we or either of us, promise to pay such additional sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorney's fees in said suit or action.
