Day, Jr. have bargained and sold, and by These presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said J. G. Day, Jr., his heirs and assigns, all of the standing merchantable timber situated on the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter, and the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter, and the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter, and the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section Fifteen (15) in Township Four (4) North of Range seven (7) East of the Willamette Meridian, in Clatsop County, State of Washington; also a right of way for logging purposes over and across the above described land.

It being mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that said timber is to be removed within five years from the date hereof, and that said right of way across said property is to expire in five years from the date hereof.

The said J. G. Day, Jr., his heirs and assigns, to have the right to go upon said land and occupy any part of it during said five years for the purposes of logging the same.
