CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits.)
 (In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and the regulations of the State Hydraulic Engineer thereunder.)

This is to certify, that E. T. Brædlove, of White Salmon, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Little Buck Creek, a tributary of Big White Salmon, for the purposes of irrigation and domestic use under Appropriation Permit No 1038, of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume One, at Page 253, on the 5th day of April, 1928; that the right hereby confirmed dates from September 12, 1927; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:
