Now on this day this cause coming on to be heard on the testimony taken and reported by the referee, Thomas A. Hudson, heretofore appointed, and the plaintiff appearing by her attorneys Gates & Bradshaw, and W. R. Ellis District Attorney appearing on the part of the State and the default of Defendant having heretofore been entered, the Court finds from the evidence reported that the allegations of the complaint herein are true: that plaintiff is and has been a resident of the State of Oregon one whole year next before the commencement of this suit. That plaintiff and defendant were lawfully married to each other in Skamania County, Washington Territory on the 25th day of December 1876; That on or about the month of July 1885, defendant ordered and drove the plaintiff from her house, and would not permit plaintiff to return to her home and live with him, and abused and called plaintiff vile names and charged her with being unchaste and threatened to kill plaintiff; That defendant has wholly failed and neglected to provide anything for the support and maintenance of plaintiff for eighteen months last past.

It is therefore adjudged and decreed that the marriage contract now existing between plaintiff and defendant be and the same is hereby dissolved, annulled and held for naught, and that plaintiff recover her costs.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT : Certificate record No. One Page-
288- State of Washington County
of Skamania

This is to certify, that R. L. Fowler, of Cook State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Bunker Creek a tributary of Little White Salmon River, for the purpose of Irrigation under appropriation Permit No. 895, of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in volume One, at page 288, on the 21st day of September, 1928; that the right hereby confirmed dates from August 21st, 1926;

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that the amount of water to which said right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.42 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: Township 3 N. Range 9 E.W.M. section 14; Forty acre tract-N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ No. acres described in permit 21, No. acres actually irrigated 8.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in Section 59, Chapter 117, session laws 1917.
