Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars lawful money of the United States of America, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents release, release, and forever quit-claim unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns all right, title, interest and estate of said first parties in and to all the certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and particularly bounded and described as follows, to wit:

- Lot #1 one, Section (33) thirty-three, Township #3 Three, North, Range #8 East Willamette Meridian, containing (6) six acres and (70) hundredths more or less according to United States survey thereof.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainders and remaindees, rents, issues and profits thereof.

To Have And To Hold all and singular the said premises, together with the appurtenances, unto said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever.


