Smith, being first duly sworn on oath says; I am now, and since prior to the 17th day of February 1928 have been, a director and clerk of the Board of Directors of School District No 17 of Skamania County Washington. That at a meeting of the Board of Directors held on the 17th day of February 1928 the resolution directing a special election for the purpose of determining whether or not the sale of certain real property should be ratified was duly passed by said Board, and the same appears of record in the minutes of the said meeting, a copy of which said resolution is hereunto annexed, marked Exhibit A. That pursuant to said resolution I caused notice of said special election to be given as provided by law, by posting three notices thereof in three of the most public places in said School District No 17, one of which was posted at the front door of School House where said election was held, one at the store of W. Glover in Underwood, and one at the Store of H. Kapp in Underwood, all in said School District No 17, a true copy of which said notice is attached hereto and marked Exhibit A, and were so posted on the 17th day of February 1928.

That at said election the total number of votes cast upon the proposition mentioned in said resolution and notice was 39, and the number of votes cast for ratification was 37 and the number of votes against ratification was 2, whereupon it was duly declared by the officers of said election that said proposition was carried, and a certificate of the result of said election was filed with the Board of Directors of said District No 17, and the said result canvassed by the board and spread upon the minutes of its meeting held March 3rd 1928.
