Certificate of Water Right

(For rights perfected under original, enlargement of secondary permits.) (In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and the regulations of the State Hydraulic Engineer thereunder)

This is to certify, that Clara E. Holtz of Jackson, State of California, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Sunker Creek a tributary of Little White Salmon River, for the purpose of irrigation under Appropriation Permit No. 1137, of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume 1 at page 345, on the 20th day of July, 1929; that the right hereby confirmed dates from July 3rd, 1928; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.42 cubic feet per second.
