

J. E. Day, Jr. to The Skamania Boom Co.

Know All Men By These Presents: That J. E. Day, Jr. unmarried, of Portland, Oregon, in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.) to one paid by The Skamania Boom Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Washington, having its principal office and place of business in the City of Vancouver, County of Clark, and State of Washington, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said corporation, The Skamania Boom Company, its successors and assigns, all of the standing merchantable timber situated upon the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter, and the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter, and the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter, and the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section fifteen (15), in Township four (4) North of Range seven (7) East of the Willamette Meridian, in Skamania County, and State of Washington; also a right of way for logging purposes over and across the above-described land.

It being mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that said timber is to be removed within five (5) years from the 30th day of March, 1900, and that said right of way across said property, is to expire in five years from said last named date.

The said corporation, The Skamania Boom Company, its successors and assigns, to have the right to go on said land and occupy any part of it during said five years, for the purpose of logging the same.

Also all the merchantable timber and the right of way and flowage for logging and booming purposes, on all that certain tract of land lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

The South half of the Southeast quarter, and the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter, and the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section nine (9) in Township four (4) North of Range seven (7) East of the Willamette Meridian; said corporation, The Skamania Boom Company, to have ten (10) years from the 26th day of June, A.D. 1900, in which to remove
