Site class: 100 Middle site III

Soils: Steever Stony Clay Loam

Soil Characteristics: Unstable when disturbed, moderately compactable when moist. Excavation should be held to a minimum and yarding should be confined to dry conditions only.

Recommendations. As this property is well stocked with a mixed species, stand management should be designed to space the trees for maximum growth regardless of specie. A large volume of firewood can be produced from this action with a few sawlogs also available. Conversion to a pure stand, if so desired, can be accomplished at time of final harvest. Suggested final harvest age is 40 to 50. Subsequent planting should not exceed 400 spa to avoid overstocking the site. Stocking at final harvest should be 250 spa.
