That R. A. Hill of the County of Skamania in the State of Washington in consideration of Five hundred dollars to me in hand paid by George M. Hauser of Clarke County, Washington, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby remise, release and forever quit-claim unto the said George M. Hauser and unto his heirs and assigns all my right, title and interest in and to the following described premises,

The undivided one fourth interest The following described Mining property. Situated and located in Ball Mountain Mining District, Skamania County, Washington, located on Blue Jacket Creek, beginning at foot of the falls on said Blue Jacket Creek, said falls being thirty feet high. Also thirty feet South of the falls on said creek that is twenty feet high. Said above described point being at the monument on North end and center of the "Wonder" Mining Claim; Thence from said monument in a North-Westerly direction running One Thousand Five Hundred feet to a monument, and also there being Three Hundred feet in width along each side of this said One Thousand Five Hundred feet, total width of said claim being Six hundred feet. This claim is known as the "Pacific" Mining claim, said "Pacific" claim join and abuts on the "Amazon" Mining claim, all of which are properly located, and recorded in Stevenson, the County seat of Skamania Co.
