said right of way to be used by said Russell, Smith & Co. as a logging
road and beginning at the South line of said land on Kanaka
Creek, following said stream across said land.

To have and to hold the same unto Russell, Smith & Co. for the period
of 15 years from the date hereof, with free use and enjoyment hereof.
