The Southeast quarter of Section Seventeen (17) Township Two (2) North, of Range Five (5) East of Willamette Meridian in Skamania County, Washington.

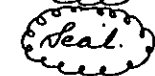
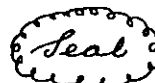

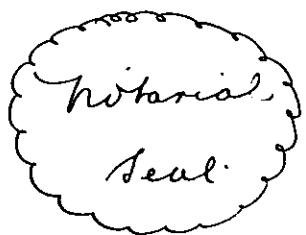
