The Grantor, William E. Thomas and Henrietta Thomas his wife of the County of Skamania, State of Washington for and in consideration of Five Hundred & \$500⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars in hand paid, conveys and warrants to Jacob Cripe and Ira Smith of the same place the following described real estate situated in Skamania County, State of Washington, to-wit: Beginning at a point thirty & 30⁰⁰/₁₀₀ degrees east and one hundred and two & 102⁰⁰/₁₀₀ rods south of the west center of section six & 6⁰⁰/₁₀₀, Township one & 1⁰⁰/₁₀₀ North of Range six & 6⁰⁰/₁₀₀ East W.M. thence north twenty & 20⁰⁰/₁₀₀ degrees and thirty five & 35⁰⁰/₁₀₀ minutes east forty-six & 46⁰⁰/₁₀₀ rods, thence north fifty-five & 55⁰⁰/₁₀₀ degrees east sixteen & 16⁰⁰/₁₀₀ rods, thence north forty-five & 45⁰⁰/₁₀₀ degrees east forty & 40⁰⁰/₁₀₀ rods, thence north fifty-two & 52⁰⁰/₁₀₀ degrees east fourteen & 14⁰⁰/₁₀₀ rods, thence north forty & 40⁰⁰/₁₀₀ degrees east eight & 8⁰⁰/₁₀₀ rods, thence north forty & 40⁰⁰/₁₀₀ degrees east fifteen & 15⁰⁰/₁₀₀ rods, thence south eighty-two & 82⁰⁰/₁₀₀ degrees east fourteen and thirty-one one-hundredths & 14³¹/₁₀₀ rods thence south seventy-nine & 79⁰⁰/₁₀₀ degrees east twenty-four and ten one hundredths & 24¹⁰/₁₀₀ rods to the Columbia river, thence along said meander line of the Columbia river to the place of beginning.
