Beginning at meander corner on line between ranges 7 and 7½ east of the Willamette Meridian and running thence west to southwest corner of the Henry Shepard Donation Land Claim in section 1, Township 2 north, range 7 east of the Willamette Meridian, having a frontage of 31.34 chains measured along said government meander line.
