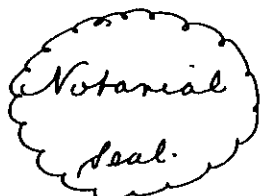

This Indenture, made the 5th day of February, 1902, between J. T. Totton, Sheriff of the County of Skamania, State of Washington, party of the first part, and S. Farrell, of the County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, the party of the second part,

Witnesseth, that whereas, by virtue of an Order of Sale duly issued out of and under the seal of the Superior Court of the State of Washington for the said County of Skamania, dated the 1st day of April, 1899, upon a decree of foreclosure and judgment duly made and entered in the said court on the 14th day of April, 1899, in a suit for the foreclosure of a Mortgage in which David Whitney Jr. was plaintiff and Jeremiah Buckley and Ella Buckley, his wife, were defendants, to the Sheriff of said County directed and delivered, commanding him to make sale of the real property hereinafter described and conveyed, and in said Decree specified.

And Whereas, in obedience to said command and under and by virtue of said order of sale, the said Sheriff did, on the 10th day of June, 1899, sell all the right, title, interest and claims of the said defendants in said suit and to the said premises, at public auction, at the Court House door, in said County of Skamania, State of Washington, between the hours of nine in the morning and four in the afternoon of that day; namely at ten o'clock A.M. after having first given due notice of the time and place of said sale according to law, to wit: by posting notices of the time and place of sale, particularly describing the property, for four weeks successively prior to the day of sale, in three of the most public places in the said County of Skamania, State of Washington, one being on the property to be sold; and also by publishing a copy of such notice once each week
