This Indenture, Made the 21<sup>st</sup> day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and two (1902) between Jack Connor of the County of Clark State Washington of the first part and Peter L. McKenzie of Portland Oregon the party of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said party of the first, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars lawful money of the United States America, to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, sold, remised, released and and forever quitclaimed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns: The Big Blue Lake or Mining Claims consisting of four claims numbers one two three and four together with the Hiawatha Lake or Claim consisting of Three Claims Number One Two and three as located surveyed and held by the said party of the first part situated in the St. Helens Mining District Skamania County, Washington.

Together with all the dips, spurs and angles, and also all the metals, ores, gold and silver bearing quartz, rock and earth therein, and all the rights, privileges and franchises thereto incident, appendant and appurtenant, or therewith usually had and enjoyed; and also all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the rents, issues and profits thereof; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, property, possession, claim and demand whatsoever, as well in law as in equity, of the said party of the first part, of, in or to the said premises, and every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances.
