

in said City of Vancouver, as platted by Esther Short, deceased, above high water line of the Columbia River, including all shore, riparian and littoral rights appertaining thereto;

46. Also all of the right, title and interest of the Railway Company in and to, and all of its right to occupy, possess and use the following described parcel of real property in the City of Vancouver, to-wit:

Commencing at the southeasterly corner of fractional block numbered twenty-six (26) in West Vancouver; thence running south on a line which is a southerly prolongation of the west line of West C Street to high water line of the Columbia River; thence northwesterly along high water line of said river down stream two hundred and twenty (220) feet more or less, to a point where the east line of West D. Street prolonged southerly would intersect high water line of said river; thence north along said line, which is a southerly prolongation of the west line of West D. Street to the southwesterly corner of said fractional block numbered twenty-six (26); thence southeasterly along the southerly line of said fractional block numbered twenty-six (26) to the point of beginning, together with all the right and privilege# of the Railway Company of erecting, establishing and maintaining thereon and removing, and taking away therefrom power houses and power stations, machinery, poles, wires, car houses, depots, stations and tracks;

47. Also the following described parcel of real property, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the north bank of the Columbia River where the east line of the United States Military Reservation at Vancouver intersects said river, and running thence easterly along the meander line of said river, ~~thence easterly~~ sixty (60) feet; thence north to the top of the said north bank of said river; thence west thirty (30) feet; thence northerly and parallel with the said east line of said Military Reservation to the County Road leading to Vancouver; thence westerly along said County Road to the said east line of said Military Reservation; thence southerly along said east line of said Military Reservation to the place of beginning;

48. Also all of the following described tide land of the first class of the State of Washington, situated in front of the city of Vancouver in said state, to-wit:

beginning at a point where the easterly line of the United States military reserve intersects inner harbor line, being south forty-four (44) minutes and forty-five (45) seconds west, ~~thence~~ one hundred and fifty and forty-seven hundredths (150.47) feet, and south sixty-four (64) degrees, twenty-five (25) minutes and thirty-nine (39) seconds east four hundred and ninety-six (496) feet, and south fifty-five (55) degrees and twenty-four (24) minutes east, two hundred and thirty-five and fifty-five hundredth (235.55) feet, and south sixty-nine (69) degrees, thirty (30) minutes and thirty-nine (39) seconds east, four hundred and seventeen (417) feet, and south sixty-four (64) degrees, twenty-five (25) minutes and thirty-nine (39) seconds east, two thousand and three hundred and ninety and forty-one hundredths (2,390.41) feet from the southeast corner of the Short donation land claim; thence south sixty-four (64) degrees, twenty-five (25) minutes and thirty-nine (39) seconds east, sixty and eight hundredths (60.08) feet along inner harbor line; thence ~~thence~~ north twenty-two (22) degrees, thirty-six (36) minutes and fifty-five (55) seconds east, four hundred and twenty-seven and forty-eight hundredths (427.48) feet along the extension of the easterly line of property to intersection of meander line; thence north fifty-six (56) degrees, forty-nine (49) minutes and six hundredths (.06) seconds west, sixty one and three hundredths (61.03) feet along meander line to southeast corner of the United States military reserve; thence south twenty-two (22) degrees, thirty-six (36) minutes and fifty-five (55) seconds west, four hundred and thirty-five and fifty-eight hundredths (435.58) feet along the extension of the easterly line of said United States reserve to the point of beginning.
