E. Mitchell and to his heirs and assigns forever, all of that certain tract of land lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington, and particularly described as follows, to-wit:-

East half of the North East Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section Thirty-six, Township Three North, Range Seven East of Willamette Meridian, containing twenty acres. Together with all and singular the servitudes, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and all of my right, title, interest, claim, possession or demand of any kind whatever, whether at law or equity, of, in or to the above described premises, and each and every part and parcel thereof.
