

two years from this date; also a right of way across the above described land for logging other timber for a period of five years from this date (except, however, that part of the land known as his clearing, including his orchard and field) together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and all of our right, title, interest, claim, possession or demand of any kind whatever, whether at law or equity, of, in or to the above described timber, and each and every part and parcel thereof.

To Have and To Hold, the same unto the said The Wind River Lumber Company and to its heirs and assigns forever.

And the said Johannes M. Fosse and Enga Fosse do hereby covenant with the said grantee its heirs and assigns, that at the date hereof we were well seized in fee simple of the timber above conveyed, and we will and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the title thereto against the lawful claims or demands of any person or persons whosoever.
