And Whereas the rights of said Russell, Smith & Company are now vested in the Skamania Boom Company, a corporation of Washington, through mesne assignments,

Now Therefore, in consideration of One Dollar, the said Skamania Boom Company does hereby release unto said John Wachter all its interest in and to all the timber upon the aforesaid premises.
