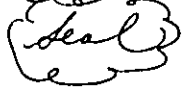

This Indenture, made the 15th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred & two between Chas. E. Schmand, Toledo Wash. party of the first part and A. C. Hooper Portland Oregon the party of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar Dollars lawful money of the United States of America, to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, remised, released and forever quitclaimed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns: The following described mining claims, known as the Washington Treadwell Discovery No 2. Beginning at a point 300 ft. S.W. of mouth of crosscut tunnel on Washington Treadwell "Primus" and running 1500 ft S.W. and 300 ft on each side of center of said line. The Discovery is about 250' S.W. of where trail crosses creek, about 1/2 mile S.E. of old Sampson Camp and about 1/2 mile N.E. of Beaver Swamp, on the West slope of Strawberry range; Also the Washington Treadwell N.E. extension - Beginning at the N.E.
