This Ordenture Witnesseth, That Elvira Gray and William F. Gray her husband for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Dollars, to us in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, ha. bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do Bargain, Sell and Convey unto Larkin T. Russell the following described premises, to-wit South West quarter of the North East quarter, South East quarter of the North West quarter, North East quarter of the South West quarter, Section thirty three, Township two of North Range six. W. M. Meridian in Washington, containing one hundred and Twenty acres together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining.

To Have and to Hold the said premises, with their appurtenances, unto the said Larkin T. Russell his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said Elvira Gray does hereby covenant to and with the said Larkin T. Russell his heirs and assigns, that she is the owner in fee simple of said premises, and they are free from all incumbrances, and that she will warrant and defend the same from all lawful claims whatsoever.
