Eymann, his wife of the County of Skamania in the State of Washington, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to us in hand paid by Flora Illinois Foster of the same place the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said Flora Illinois Foster and to her heirs and assigns forever, all of that certain tract of land lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington, and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the northwest corner of the South West quarter of Section Seventeen, Township Three North of Range Eight East of Willamette Meridian, running thence Eighty rods east, thence South forty rods, thence west Eighty rods, thence north forty rods to the place of beginning, containing twenty acres.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and all of our right, title, interest, claim, possession or demand of any kind whatever, whether at law or equity, of, in or to the above described premises, and each and every part and parcel thereof.

To Have and to Hold the same unto the said Flora Illinois Foster and to her heirs and assigns forever.

And the said Lewis Eymann, and Harriett E. Eymann do hereby covenant with the said grantee her heirs and assigns, that at the date hereof we were well seized in fee simple of the premises above conveyed, and we will and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the title thereto against the lawful claims or demands of any person or persons whomsoever.
