Eyman, his wife of the County of Skamania in the State of Washington, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to us in hand paid by Lavinia Elvira Foster of the same place the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said Lavinia Elvira Foster and to her heirs and assigns forever, all of that certain tract of land lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington, and particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point 80 rods east of the north west corner of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, Township 3 North, Range 8 East of Willamette Meridian; running thence East 40 rods, thence South 40 rods, thence west 40 rods, thence north 40 rods to the place of beginning, containing 10 acres together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and all of our right, title, interest, claim, possession or demand of any kind whatever, whether at law or equity, of, in or to the above described premises, and each and every part and parcel thereof.
