Know All Men by These Presents, That Norman J. Smedley, the party of the first part, for and in consideration of One Dollars, to him in hand paid, do hereby bargain, give and grant to A. E. Noble the party of the second part, for the period of thirty days from the date hereof, the sole, exclusive and irrevocable right and privilege of purchasing that certain tract, or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the county of Skamania and State of Washington, and more particularly bounded and described as follows, to wit: South east quarter section 9, T. 2. N. R. 5 E. W. M. at and for the agreed price of Eight hundred Dollars, to be paid (if the said party of the second part shall elect to purchase hereunder), in manner and form as follows, to wit: To be paid in cash as soon as deed is recorded and abstract furnished showing perfect title in said Norman J. Smedley, and in case said party of the second part shall elect to purchase said premises hereunder, and shall pay or offer to pay said consideration to said party of the first part, in time, manner and form as hereinbefore specified, then the said party of the first part upon his part, agree forthwith to convey said premises free of all encumbrances to said party of the second part, by good and sufficient deeds with all covenants of warranty; but in case said party of the second part shall not within said thirty days elect to purchase said premises as aforesaid then this agreement shall at the expiration of said thirty days become at once null and void, and the said party of the first part may and shall retain to himself own use and benefit all money before that time paid hereunder.
