This Indenture Witnesseth that we Christian Aalvik and Anna Aalvik his wife, in consideration of Two hundred fifty Dollars to us in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and conveyed and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto said Ash and Attwell, the following described premises to-wit:

The southeast quarter of Section fourteen in Township three North of Range eight (8) East of W.M except the timber ~~####~~ on the South half of said Southeast quarter said section Township and range, in Skamania County State of Washington, containing 160 acres, together with the tenements her ditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold unto the said Ash & Attwell their successors and assigns forever.

This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of two hundred fifty dollars in accordance with the tenor of a certain promissory note of which the following is a copy:

2 Stevenson Wash July 13th 1907.

On or before 6 months after date for value received we promise to pay to Ash & Attwell the sum of two hundred fifty dollars with interest thereon at the rate of 8 per cent per annum. If the interest is not paid when due it shall be compounded with the principal and bear like interest, principal and interest payable in United States Gold coin, and in case suit is instituted to collect this note or any portion thereon we promise to pay such additional sum as the Court may
