

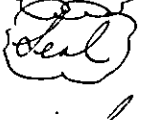
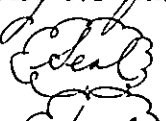
Also, an undivided one third interest in all their interest in and to all water rights, rights-of-way, flumes and ditches on, over or across said lands, or any part thereof, or appurtenant thereto. Reserving, however, from the foregoing conveyance all personal property, including poles, cordwood, machinery, logging tools, brick and iron which may be upon any of said tracts, belonging to The Oregon Lumber Company; and also reserving the right for said Oregon Lumber Company to the use, for a reasonable time, of the flume running across portions of said land, for the purpose of fluming to the Columbia River any wood or poles upon any of said premises belonging to said Oregon Lumber Company, and the right to enter without let or hindrance any of said premises, for a reasonable time, for the purpose of fluming said wood or poles, and removing said machinery, tools, brick and iron. It being the intention of this instrument to Release and Quit Claim unto the said J. D. Casey, an undivided one third of all that real estate, with said reservations, duly excepted and reserved, as is contained in a certain Deed of Quit Claim executed by said Oregon Lumber Company to said Henderson and Thort, Dated March 15, 1902, duly acknowledged and recorded in Deed Records of Skamania County in Book "H" at page 72, reference to which deed is hereby made and the same is made a part hereof for all the purposes hereof. Of the above consideration the sum of \$686.⁰⁰/₁₀₀ is paid in cash, and for the balance of \$1103.96, the said J. D. Casey, hereby assumes and agrees to pay off and discharge, an undivided one third part of a certain purchase price Mortgage on said lands in the sum of \$3311.90 and interest from the date thereof executed by the grantors herein in favor of said Oregon Lumber Company.

To Have and to Hold the same, together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining to the said J. D. Casey and to his heirs and assigns forever.
