Together with all the dips, spurs and angles, and also all the metals, ores, gold and silver-bearing quartz, rock and earth therein; and all the right, privileges and franchises thereto incident, appendant and appurtenant, or therewith usually had and enjoyed; and also, all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the rents, issues and profit thereof; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, property possession, claim and demand whatsoever, as well in law as in equity, of the said party of the first part, of, in or to the said premises, and every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances.

To Have And To Hold, all and singular, the said premises, together with the appurtenances and privileges thereto incident, unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.

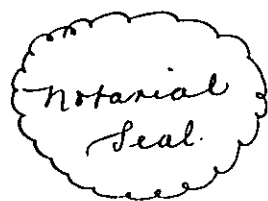
