

R. D. Cannon and Wife to White Salmon Boom and Imp Co

Know all men by these Presents That we R. D. Cannon and N. A. Cannon husband and wife in consideration of one dollar to us in hand paid by the White Salmon Boom and Improvement Company a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Washington the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby give grant bargain sell and convey to said White Salmon Boom and Improvement Company its successors and assigns the right to drive and float logs lumber and other timber products in the White Salmon river when the same passes through the north half of the north east quarter and the north east quarter of the north west quarter of section ten township three north range ten east W. M. in the state of Washington and also the right to build maintain and operate dams in said stream where the same passes through the said premises whenever necessary or convenient for using said stream for said purposes. Together with the right to pass over said land and use the same for the purpose of using said stream as aforesaid at any place within two hundred feet on each side of the center of said stream where it flows through the above described tract; the said R. D. and N. A. Cannon having the right to use said premises and every portion thereof for agricultural and other purposes they not to be excluded from any portion of the same by said White Salmon Boom and Improvement Company excepting so far as may be necessary for the purposes aforesaid The White Salmon Boom and Improvement Company to have the right of ingress and egress to said stream by passing over the above described premises at such places as are practicable and as may be hereafter designated by the grantees herein. The White Salmon Boom and Improvement Company in using said premises as above indicated are to do no unnecessary damage and whatever damage may be done by said company to the premises above mentioned are to be fully paid for by the said company.
