and do hereby give grant bargain sell and convey
unto the said White Salmon Boom and Improvement
Company aforesaid and to its successors and assigns
forever the right to use the stream known as the
White Salmon River together with a strip of land
one hundred feet wide on each side of said stream
measuring from the line of ordinary high water
