This indenture made this twentieth day of August A. D. 1902 by and between Charles Olson and Andy Olson bachelors of the town of Toledo County of Lewis and State of Washington parties of the first part and Hamilton Petcher Louis Carlson and Thomas A. Gray all of of Lewis County, Washington parties of the second part Witnesseth That said parties of the first part in consideration of Fourteen Hundred Dollars paid to said parties of the first part by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold quit claimed and released and by these presents do bargain sell release and quit claim unto said Hamilton Petcher, Louis Carlson and Thomas A. Gray their successors and assigns all the right title interest estate claim and demand of the said party of the first part of in and to The following described tracts lots or parcels of land situate lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington particularly bounded and described as follows to-wit: All those certain Mining claims known as "The Gold Hawk" Number one (1) and Number two (2), The Great Rock Number one (1) and Number two (2), The Denver Number one (1) and Number two (2) and The Alvia Number one and Number two (2), all lying and being in the Skelens Mining District said County and State, Together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversion remainder and remainders rents issues and profits thereof, To Have And To Hold The above quit claimed premises with all and singular the appurtenances unto the said parties of the second part and to their heirs and assigns forever.
