And the said Martha Hollis for her heirs executors and administrators does covenant with the said Wind River Lumber Company heirs and assigns that she is the lawful owner in fee simple of the said premises that they are free from all liens and incumbrances whatever and she will and her heirs executors and administrators shall Forever Warrant and Defend the same against all lawful claims whatever.
