Coulter to Wood

Knew all men by these presents that I, John M.Coulter, the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two thousand (2000) Dollars in legal tender of the United States of America to me in hand paid by Alfred Wood, the party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, assigned transferred and set over and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell assign, transfer and set over unto the said party of the second part a certain Indenture of Mortgage bearing date the 18th day of March 1908, made and executed by Alden Kingman and Emma Kingman his wife to the said parties of the first part, to secure the payment of the sum of Four thousand (4000) Dollars, together with the promissory notes or obligation therein described and the money due or to grow due thereon, with the interest; which said Indenture of Mortgage was recorded in the office of the Auditor of the County of Skamania State of Washington in Book "H" of Mortgages, page 145, on the 26th day of March 1908. To have and to hold the same unto the said party of the second part his executors administrators and assigns for his use and benefit subject only to the proviso in the said Indenture of Mortgage mentioned.
