Lots One (1) and Two (2) of the North half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Northwest quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section twenty (20) in Township one (1) North of Range five (5) East of Willamette Meridian containing 63 acres, in Skamania County State of Washington, together with the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining.
