This Indenture, Made this 5th day of December, a. d. 1902. Between Mary Bennett, Agnes Bennett and Bird Bennett, of Toledo, Washington, parties of the first part, and Chas Bartram and Ulrich Gutfreund, of Portland, Oregon, parties of the second part: Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred (\$100.) Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to them in hand paid by the said parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents renounce, release and forever quit-claim unto the said parties of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns, all right, title interest and estate of said first parties in and to all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington and particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit: A Mining claim situated in the St Helens Mining District in Skamania County, Washington, known as Mountain Fairy No. 2, the location notice of which has been recorded in the County Auditor's
