

Theodore Bergman et al to Mt. Fairy Mining Co.

This indenture made this 11th day of November A. D. 1902 between Theodore Bergmann and Margartha Bergmann, his wife, Charles Bartram and Cecilia Bartram, his wife, Carl Siegel (unmarried) N. Gittfuchs and Marie Gittfuchs, his wife and F. X. Dillmann and Margartha Dillmann, his wife parties of the first part, and the Mt. Fairy Mining Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Oregon, party of the second part, Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of \$100 lawful money of the United States of America and other good and valuable considerations to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents release, release and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, all right, title interest and estate of the said parties of the first part in and to all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and particularly described as follows, to-wit: Mining claim situated in the St. Helens Mining District in Skamania County Washington known as the Mountain Fairy No. 1. The location notice of which has been recorded in the County Auditor's Office in Chehalis, Lewis County, Washington, on Page 307, of Book 4, of Mining claims; said claim described as follows, to-wit: commencing at a stake in the center of claim upon which the location notice is posted, running Northeast 300 feet to a stake; thence Northwest 100 feet to a stake; thence Southwest 300 feet to a post marked N. W. end corner stake, being the center of the head lode and of claim; thence Southwest 300 feet to a corner post; thence Southeast 1500 feet to a corner post; thence Northeast 300 feet to the place of beginning, situated in Florence Creek, about 1600 feet Northwest of Lake Meta and about one mile Southwest of Mt. Bismark.
