

three hundred feet East of the Mountain King Falls, being the first prominent falls East and up and above the forks of the North Toulle River and Mining Creek and extending from said discovery point in an Easterly direction along the center line of said Lode fifteen hundred linear feet and being three hundred feet in width on each side of said center line, the center and lines and corners of said claim are marked with blazed trees with the respective center and lines and corners marked thereon.

IV. The Blue Bird Lode Discovery Claim No 2 West, beginning at discovery thereof which is about three hundred feet East of the Mountain King Lode and is also about three hundred feet East of what is known as Mountain King Falls which is about one half mile and the first prominent falls East and up from the well known forks of the North Toulle River and Mining Creek, extending from said discovery in a Westerly direction fifteen hundred linear feet along the center line of said Lode and three hundred feet in width on each side of said center line, the respective center and lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center and lines and corners marked thereon, claim being bounded on the East by Blue Bird Discovery Claim No 1 East.

V. The Star King Lode, First Discovery No 1 East, beginning at the top of what is known as Box Creek Canyon Falls and on the North side thereof and about 25 feet E. S. E. from notice placed on yellow cedar Tree which is on the southwest slope of the Strawberry range of mountains and about 3000 feet West of Box Canyon basin, and running from said commencement point in a Southerly direction 300 feet to the Southwest corner stake, thence 1500 feet in an Easterly direction to the Southeast corner stake, thence 600 feet in a northerly direction to the northwest corner stake, thence 1500 feet in a westerly direction to the northwest corner stake, thence 300 feet in a southerly direction to the discovery at the point of beginning.

VI. The Star King Lode, First Discovery claim No 2 West, commencing at the Star King Lode, First Discovery No 1 East, herein above mentioned, running from thence in a southerly direction 300 feet to the southeast corner stake, thence 1500 feet in a westerly direction to the southwest corner stake, thence 600 feet in a northerly direction to the northwest corner stake, thence 1500 feet in an easterly direction to the northeast corner stake, thence 300 feet in a southerly direction to the place of beginning.

VII. The Star King Lode, Second Discovery No. 1 East beginning at the discovery point which is in Box Creek Canyon and about 3000 feet in an Easterly direction from what is known as the top of Box Creek Canyon Falls, which Falls is on the Southwest slope of the Strawberry Range of Mountains and adjacent to the First Discovery of Star King Lode, running from said discovery in a Southerly direction 300 feet to the Southwest corner stake, thence in an Easterly direction 1500 feet to the Southeast corner stake,
