Ordway & Weidler to Oregon Lumber Co.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, George H. Weidler, Hattie L. Weidler, Julius Ordway & June Ordway, in consideration of Five Thousand Dollars, to us paid by Oregon Lumber Company do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey to said Oregon Lumber Company their heirs and assigns forever, the parcel of real estate situate, lying and being in Skamania County, State of Washington and bounded and particularly described as follows, to wit:

The West half of the North East quarter - the West half of the South East quarter - the East half of the North West quarter - the East half of the South West quarter - the West half of the South West quarter of Section 12, containing Four Hundred (400) acres - The East half of the North East quarter - the East half of the South East quarter - the South West quarter and the South half of the North West quarter of Section 14 - containing Four Hundred (400) acres - The West half of the North West quarter and the West half of the South West quarter of Section 24, containing One Hundred and Sixty (160) acres. All of the above Nine Hundred and Sixty (960) acres being in Township Three North of Range Nine East of Willamette Meridian in the State of Washington - Also a certain flume commencing in Section one of the above township, and running thence in a Southerly direction to the Columbia River and a barge known as "No. 1." lying at the mouth of said flume in the Columbia River.
