Shelley to Boyd

This Indenture Witnesseth, That Roswell Shelley and Rose Shelley, husband and wife, in consideration of two hundred (\$200.00) Dollars to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto Jas M. Boyd of Carson, Wash, the following described premises to-wit:

Beginning at a point thirty feet east and 39 rods and one half foot south of the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of Sec. 29 Tp. 3 N. R. 8 E. W. M., thence running east one hundred feet thence south ninety eight feet, thence west one hundred feet, thence north ninety eight feet to point of beginning, containing one lot 98 x 100 feet. Together with tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, to have and to hold the same with the appurtenances unto the said Jas M. Boyd, his heirs and assigns forever.

This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of two hundred Dollars and the interest thereon in accordance with the tenor of a certain promissory note, of which the following is a copy, to-wit:
