Together with, all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining; and also all our estate, right, title and interest, in and to the same, including power and claim of power. To Have and to Hold the above described and granted premises unto the said A. T. Lewis his heirs and assigns forever.
